PUBLIC NOTICE FOR PUTTING 4TH HANDLOOM CENSUS DATA IN PUBLIC DOMAIN

Purpose: - All concerned are requested to access 4th All India handloom census data and inform about any addition/alteration/rectification/deletion which needs to be done, to the nearest Weavers Service Centre or Concerned State Government/UTs Department for necessary rectification.

4th All India Handloom Census was conducted by Ministry of Textiles and the report was released on 07th August 2019. The handloom census was conducted through M/s Karvy Data Management Services Limited (KDMSL), Hyderabad by carrying out door to door survey of the households and non-household weaving units.

- 2. Field level validation of entire enumerated data was carried out on the following items:-
 - (a) Whether a person has been wrongly included in the data that is neither a handloom weaver nor engaged in activities allied to handloom weaving.
 - (b) Whether a genuine handloom weaver or allied worker has been left out.
 - (c) The districts having 10% reduction in the number of households in comparison to 3rd Handloom Census were revisited again by enumerators.
 - (d) A portal was developed for States to do online validation and checking the authenticity of data collected at District level; and uploading of validation report through login/password for 100% census data validation.
 - (e) The data validations exercise was taken up at block level.
 - (f) During validation, State Governments intimated time to time left out pockets for which the enumeration was carried out.
 - (g) For improving the accuracy of 4th National Handloom Census, a series of meeting were organized time to time by DC(HL), with M/s KDMSL, Zonal Directors of Weaver Service Centers and representatives of State Governments.
 - (h) State Governments carried out 100% validation of enumerated data through online portal for which user ID and passwords were given to State officials at district level.
 - (i) The enumeration was treated as complete only after getting completion certificates from respective State/UT Governments.
 - (j) State wise Newspaper advertisement were released for public viewing the data collected and seeking information about discrepancy and non-inclusion from the handloom weavers and allied workers.

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- 3. Enumeration work was completed and completion certificate from 31 States/UTs were received with 100% validation of enumerated data from the respective States by 08th July 2019.
- 4. Now, in order to make the data dynamic and updated it has been decided to put the census data in public domain.
